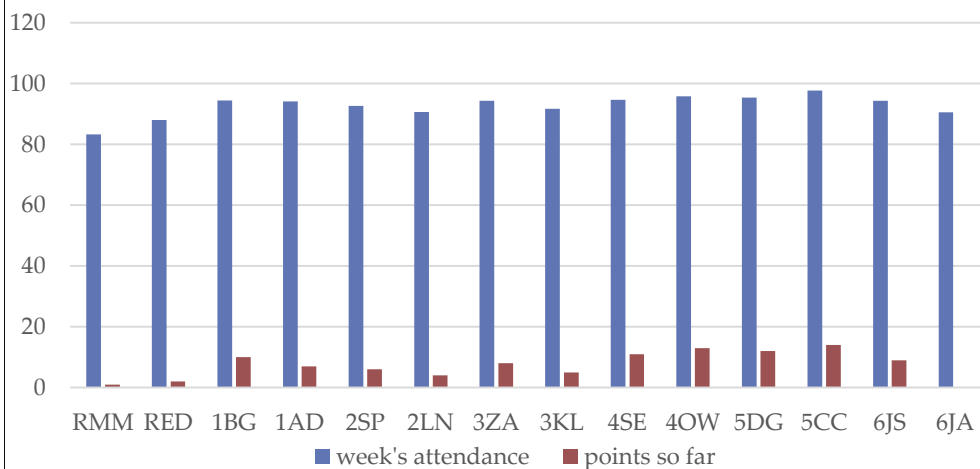
The Daily Supported Reading programme, together with parental support is really making a difference to the standard of reading.
