On Tuesday an actor came into school so that the children in years 4,5 and 6 could experience a lesson as it would have been in 1936.



We set a classroom up with props borrowed from other local schools and old photographs.

The children's reactions were priceless when they had to use chalkboards, pretend to have a spoonful of cod liver oil and the teacher even

separated the boys and girls. It was a shock to the girls that that they would learn how to cook and learn how to run a household!

Dance and Drama

Years 2 and 3 worked with a dance academy to produce an assembly about the 1930s. The children listened to music from the era and were taught about big news stories of 1936, including the Jarrow marches.

Awards for the school


We are delighted to announce that we have achieved two more awards.
