School Dinners



Price increase

After the Easter holiday the prices of our school dinners will be increasing by **£0.10** (meaning a total of **£2.20** per meal). The reason for this is that currently the dinners cost the school **£2.50** and when school budgets are being cut we can no longer subsidise this additional cost. We want to make sure all of our money is spent on ensuring the very best education for your child. All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will still receive free school meals.

Will there be any changes to the meals?

We are working very closely with the catering team at Enfield to ensure that the school dinners are the very best that they can be.

Mrs Pearson, Mr Smart and the Governors met with the team at Enfield Catering to explain that sometimes they run out of one particular choice of dinner and that some children do not like some of the dinners on offer.

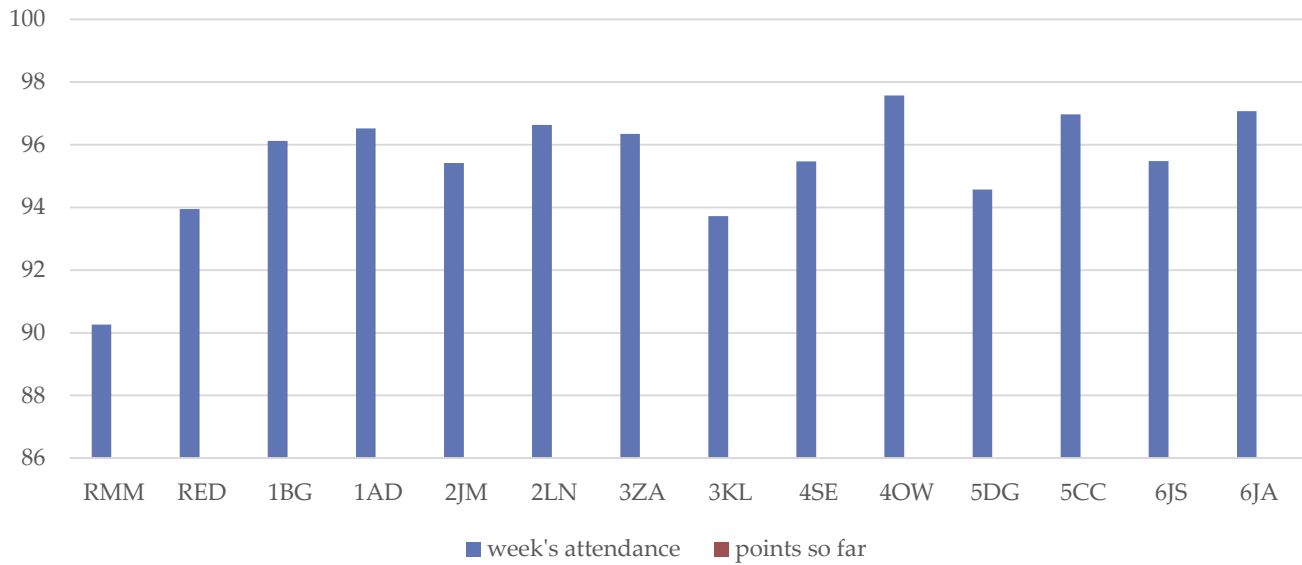
We agreed the following:

1. Leading up to the Easter holidays Enfield Catering will ensure that both choices on the menu are definitely available every day – even if it means they have to cook extra than is needed.
2. A new menu will be introduced (attached to this newsletter). There will be a three week trial period where Mrs Pearson, Mr Smart and the Governors will check the quality of the food and what the children like and do not like.
3. Mrs Pearson, Mr Smart and the Governors will meet with Enfield Catering again in May to explain exactly what the children at De Bohun want for their school dinners and expect that they can provide it.

Following that final meeting we will send out a letter explaining exactly what the new menu will look like and what you can expect for the increased cost.

We want the very best for our children, even if that means sorting out the school dinners!
