Admission Information

Once a space is offered by the London Borough of Enfield, we will contact you to arrange an admission interview.

Children are invited to spend a morning in their new class, meet their peers and complete some basic assessment in Reading, Writing & Mathematics. During the morning your child will be assigned a “buddy” who will help to make their settling in period a positive experience. Admission interviews are held on a Thursday morning with a start date given for the following Monday.

During that morning, parents will meet with the Admissions Officer to complete school paperwork, tour the school and be given the chance to answer any questions that they may have.

Children accepting places in our Pre-School, will be offered a tour by our Manager, Mrs Helen Rodgers and a settling in period offered.
