It gives me great pleasure to be able to share with you our end of year outcomes for our statutory assessments in Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 6.

## **Reception**

This year we attained 69% Good Level of Development. This is a 9% increase on our result from last year and is in line with national expectations. We are also pleased to share that 83% of our children who attended our Nursery and Pre-School achieved this standard – which is well above national expectations.

## Year 1 – Phonics Screening Check

This year 98% of our children achieved the expected standard in the Phonics Screening Check. This is 15% above last year's national expectations and 15% higher than last year.

This year we have exceeded the national expectations of 2018 in all areas (reading, writing, maths and phonics). We have also increased last year's outcomes considerably in all areas.

This year, we have increased the percentage of children reaching the expected standard in all areas, apart from reading which remains broadly similar to last year. We have exceeded national expectations in writing and maths and in the number of children achieving the expected standard across all subjects.


### **Greater Depth**
