Attendance rates and persistent absence



Every child should have an attendance rate of at least **96%**. Any attendance below this level, or any persistent absence, is flagged as a concern. Persistent absence is missing 10% or more of school sessions.

1

If your child's attendance falls below 96%, the school will contact you and monitor your child's absence more closely. 2

If there is no improvement in two weeks, the school will arrange a meeting with you. Staff will support you to see what is causing your child's absence.

3

If persistent absence continues after this, a further meeting will be arranged.

4

Following this, if there is no improvement, the local council will be contacted to issue a fine.
