Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you are all well looking forward to the Summer break.

I am writing to welcome you and your child to their new year group in Years 4, 5 and 6 and to let you know that I am looking forward to working with you all this coming academic year.

Some other important, key information I would like to share with you is set out below which will hopefully enable your child's transition to their new class to be as secure and comfortable as possible:

Bubbles

Year groups will create their own 'bubbles'. This means that the children and staff will remain the same as far as possible and 'bubbles' will not mix with other bubbles within the school.

School timings

To ensure that we limit the number of people in the playground at one time, we have staggered the drop off and collection times for all year groups. Classes will line up separately in order to reduce the risk of contact.

Please do not cross any barriers in the playground as they are there to protect you and your child. You will have a 10-minute slot to drop off and pick up your child.

The start and end times of the school day are as follows:

Year group	Morning drop off times	End of the day collection times
Year 4	8.40 am	3.10 pm
Years 5 and 6	8.50 am	3.20 pm

Uniform/PE

- All children should wear their full De Bohun school uniform on their return in September.
- Year 6 children have a slightly different uniform and should wear a button-up white shirt, De Bohun tie and V-neck jumper or sweatshirt. These can be purchased from Smiths School wear in Cockfosters.
- On their allotted P.E days, your child should come to school in their P.E kit which will be worn throughout the day. This will avoid them having to change their clothes. You will be given your child's P.E days at the start of the new term in September by the class teacher.

Assemblies

- Whole school assemblies will be replaced with 'virtual assemblies' and your child will be able to take part in these within their phase.

Social distancing/Hand washing/Hand sanitising

Children will be able to sit with the other children in their 'bubble'. They cannot interact with children in other year groups or 'bubbles'. Any soft furnishings or soft toys (difficult to keep clean) will continue to be removed from classrooms. Hand sanitiser will be applied by staff to children's hands as they enter their classroom and as they leave the classroom. Anti-bacterial hand wash is available in every classroom and children will be encouraged to be used during class activities or at specified times of the day. Each child will have their own pencil case with their own equipment in order to limit contact with shared resources.

I look forward to welcoming you and your children back to De Bohun In September and hope that you have a happy and safe Summer holiday. I will be available to discuss what I have shared with you in this letter and any other concerns with you may have in September.
